THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS PASSED SB 811 KNOWN AS THE TEXAS RABIES CONTROL ACT OF 1981 (HEALTH AND SAFTETY CODE, TITILE 10. HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ANIMALS, CHAPTER 826 RABIES).

WHEREAS:

THE TEXAS BOARD OF HEALTH HAS ADOPTED RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT WHICH HAVE BEEN DULY PUBLISHED IN THE TEXAS REGISTER.

WHEREAS:

THE TEXAS RABIES CONTROL ACT OF 1981 REQUIRES EACH COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY IN TEXAS TO PROVIDE A LOCAL RABIES CONTROL AUTHORITY FOR PURPOSES OF LOCAL ADMINIS-TRATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT.
